The purpose of this letter is to transmit a copy of the Supply System's Performance Enhancement Strategy Plan. The attached plan was developed by an independent management team in response to the mid-cycle, self-assessment. The self-assessment was completed during February 1995 and presented to the Region IV staff during a meeting on March 14, 1995.

The self-assessment identified numerous areas which required management attention to effect enhancements and improvements. These areas are addressed in the plan, which includes several programmatic and process initiatives. Essential elements of this plan were given to the Region IV staff on July 28, 1995. However, since that time, the plan has been revised and finalized. Current plans are to present an update of this document to the Region IV staff during August 1995.

The Supply System considers this plan to be an integral part of our continued efforts to improve performance which pulled together corrective actions in different directorates into a single document. The plan is intended to be a living document which will be continually updated and amended as necessary. Furthermore, subsequent revisions to the plan will be submitted to the Region IV staff for information.

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
