Dear Mr. Callan:

Enclosed is a copy of the final report for the September 25, 1996, plume exposure pathway exercise of the offsite radiological emergency response plans for Washington Nuclear Plant No. 2 (WNP-2). The report also contains the results of out-of-sequence drills in which biennial exercise requirements were demonstrated. The State of Washington and the Washington Counties of Benton and Franklin fully participated in the exercise and the State of Oregon partially participated.

There were no Deficiencies identified during the exercise or related drills. There were, however, twelve Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) identified. FEMA Region X staff will monitor the status of corrective actions for the twelve ARCAs as well as the other ARCAs that remain open from previous WNP-2 drills and exercises.

Based on the results of the September 25, 1996, exercise, the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the States of Oregon and Washington and affected local jurisdictions, site-specific to WNP-2, can be implemented and are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at WNP-2. Therefore, our approval of the State and local government WNP-2 radiological emergency response plans under the Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) program remains in effect.
