Eastern CT Cardiology Associates, LLC (the transferee), is licensed to operate a nuclear cardiac imaging, outpatient center at 43 West Middle Tpke, Manchester, CT. Hartford Cardiology Group, LLC (the transferor), will transfer into and become the a new location of radioactive material use on the Eastern CT Cardiology Associates specific license. There will be no change in the radiation safety program or procedures currently in effect for Eastern CT Cardiology Associates, LLC, other than the inclusion of the West Hartford site into our radiation safety program, and, the East Hartford site address will remain closed.

1. The transfer will result in our management assuming the operational control of Hartford Cardiology Group, LLC.
2. Thomas I. Knox, MD, and authorized user will be added as an AU physician member of Eastern CT Cardiology Associates, LLC, for material and uses of 35.100 and 35.200 on this license.
3. There are no plans for decommissioning the West Hartford facility; the radiation safety equipment and the sources currently onsite will continue to be used in the same location, and, following the radiation safety program that we maintain.
4. The status of the Hartford Cardiology Group, LLC, program and facilities is best described as dormant. The last use of licensed materials and of the surveillance program (surveys, wipe tests, QC) was in November 2016. The end of day surveys demonstrated no contamination for the wipe tests and the area/imaging room radiation level surveys were routine. Finally, the reference sources were again stored in the Hot Lab and the entry door was locked. Presently, our physicist &


RSO has returned to West Hartford to perform: dose calibrator initial setup QA (accuracy, syringe geometry, linearity), sending the survey meter out for calibration (backup unit is onsite), and the records, logbooks and license documentation were all verified to be in place in order to restart the imaging service.

5. Neither license requires a DFP.
6. There are no plans for a formal decommissioning of the facility. The records from the prior operation of the West Hartford site will be kept in the event of an inspection.
7. Eastern CT Cardiology Associates, LLC and Hartford Cardiology Associates, LLC are both in agreement on this transfer of control. This letter bears the signature of representatives for both NRC Material Licenses to that effect.
8. Eastern CT Cardiology Associates, LLC (the transferee), will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of Hartford Cardiology Group, LLC (the transferor).
