

ANSWER

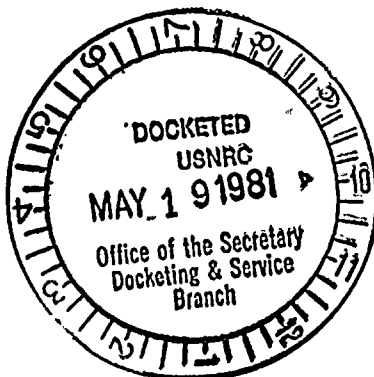
