
Dear Mr. Knighton:

The referenced letter addressed the outstanding LOCA doses issue. It analyzed Spray Chemical Storage Tank (SCST) accessibility, post accident, and provided explanation for six indicators which may be used to determine need for restart of the Iodine Removal System (IRS).

The appropriate procedures will include the six indicators, to assure a constant supply of hydrazine, and the criteria for refilling the SCST. The procedures will be in place, prior to Unit 1 fuel load.
