This letter requests an extension of time for responding to Section 2.2.2 of the referenced letter from PVNGS Units 1, 2 and 3. We are a member of a Nuclear Utility Task Action Committee (NUTAC) formed on September 1, 1983, for the specific purpose of defining either an appropriate vendor interface program or an acceptable alternative. This NUTAC is meeting under the auspices of INPO's Analysis and Engineering Industry Review Group with the support of INPO.

In view of our continuing participation in the SEE-IN and NPRDS programs, we believe that a time extension will have no immediate impact on public health and safety.

While participating in the NUTAC, we will concurrently evaluate, in more detail, our existing capabilities for interfacing with our vendors. After completion of the NUTAC's efforts, projected to be February 1, 1983, we will submit our program description to the NRC by March 5, 1984.
