Dear Mr. Knighton:

The referenced letter provided you a copy of our spray pond monitoring program described in our procedure 73AC-9SP01, "Spray Pond Piping Integrity Verification." In addition to the monitoring outlined in that procedure, APS will conduct a reexamination of the Diesel Generator Cooling and Essential Cooling Water Systems on PVNGS Units 1 and 2.

The scope of this reexamination is proposed as follows:

Examination Criteria

- o Unusual Rust Formation or Deposits
- o Tube Blockage
- o Excessive Pitting of Heat Exchanger Tube or Tube Sheets
- o Indicators of Stress Corrosion Cracking

Components to be Examined

- o Diesel Generator Jacket Cooling Water Heat Exchanger
- o Essential Cooling Water Heat Exchanger
- o Accessable Piping at Heat Exchangers

Examination Schedule

- o Unit 2 Train A or B
 - Hot Functional Test (approximately late June 1985) Visual Exam
- o Unit 1 Train A or B
 - First Refueling Visual Exam


