ATTACHMENT

ITEM: Revising procedures so that EER non-technical resolutions have the identified corrective actions assigned to the appropriate department manager (50-529/86-33-03).

RESPONSE: A telephone conversation was held between Mr. R. C. Barr of the NRC and various members of the ANPP staff on May 27, 1987, to clarify his concern. The following action is being taken in response to his concern.

Operations Engineering is currently developing a distribution list which will indicate the organization that is responsible to take further action. The manager of the organization that is affected by the disposition will then be sent the disposition for their evaluation of necessary actions, as required. The EER will not be tracked by engineering since it is incumbent upon the affected organization to develop actions to resolve a concern. The dispositioned EER will continue to be sent to the initiator.

It is expected that the procedure will be modified to reflect this change by July 30, 1987.
