- March 1989 - Based on a review of the forced outage definition and the circumstances leading to the shutdown of Unit 2, we are reclassifying the Unit 2 outage as a "maintenance" outage instead of a forced outage. The 390.7 hours of outage should have been listed as scheduled outage hours.
- April 1989 - Since the outage was a continuation from March, the 720 hours of outage should have been listed as scheduled outage hours.
- May 1989 - Since the outage was a continuation from April, the 744 hours of outage should have been listed as scheduled outage hours.
