Sorry for the delayed response. I'm good – thank you! In short, no to my knowledge the NRC has not ordered Seabrook to dewater Unit 2. I will forward your question to Fred Bower so that he can decide whether it would be appropriate to document the answer to this question in a formal way. In addition, I'm sure you are aware that NextEra has submitted a license amendment request to request approval of a methodology to analyze seismic Category I concrete structures affected by ASR.
