In accordance with 10 CFR 50, Appendix E.V, enclosed please find copies of revised PVNGS Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures (EIPs). The procedures included with this transmittal are indicated on the enclosed list. Included for your information is a complete listing of the PVNGS EIPs (Procedures Index). Also, for your information, EIP-04, "Alert, Site Area and General Emergency Implementing Actions" has been superseded by EIP-03, "Notification of Unusual Event Implementing Actions." The new title for EIP-03 is "Emergency Classification Implementing Actions." Due to an administrative oversight, EIP-58 was revised in April 1995 but was not previously submitted. EIP-58 is included with this submittal. PVNGS performed a review of all EIPs, and confirmed that all other EIPs have been submitted.

The enclosed EIPs contain information considered private or proprietary (including names and internal telephone numbers). In accordance with Generic Letter No. 81-27, the specific information has been bracketed on the EIPs. Arizona Public Service Company (APS) requests that this information be considered confidential and withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(a) and 10 CFR 9.17(a).

By copy of this letter, APS is forwarding two copies of the enclosure to the NRC Region IV Office. Copies of the revised EIPs are provided to the NRC Resident Inspectors' Office as an update to the assigned controlled procedures.
