NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY  
OPERATING LICENSE  
AND NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment Nos. 28 and 10 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-58 and DPR-74 issued to Indiana and Michigan Electric Company, which revised the Appendix A Technical Specifications for operation of the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2 (the facilities), located in Berrien County, Michigan.

These changes authorize the removal of part-length control rods in place of the part-length rods (PLR) for Unit 1 and installation of permanent anti-rotational devices on the PLR lead screws for both Units 1 and 2. Also, part-length rods will not be installed for operation in Unit 2. All provisions for PLRs have been removed from the Unit 2 Technical Specifications.

The application for the amendments complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's regulations. The Commission has made.

appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendments.

The Commission has determined that the issuance of these amendments will not result in any significant environmental impact and that pursuant to 10 CFR §51.5(d)(4) an environmental impact statement or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with issuance of these amendments.
