This letter and its attachment transmit proposed new Technical Specification change requests concerning the Reactor Coolant System Vents that have been installed pursuant to the requirements of Item II.B.1 of NUREG-0737. The Basis for the specification is also attached. This proposed Technical Specification is transmitted pursuant to your request contained in Generic Letter 83-37 that we submit these Technical Specifications separately from the remainder of the items in Generic Letter 83-37. The attachment to this letter contains the proposed new specifications for Units 1 and 2 of the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant.

The system design, associated background information, and additional information requested by you was transmitted in our letters AEP:NRC:0584 (dated July 15, 1981), and AEP:NRC:0584A (dated June 28, 1982). These letters described the vents that we have at the two plants as those in the pressurizer steam space and the reactor vessel head. Therefore, these are the only two areas that are addressed in the Technical Specifications.

The proposed new specifications are modeled after those suggested in Generic Letter 83-37, but include plant-specific provisions to accommodate the actual systems we have installed at the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant. Based on concerns raised by our Nuclear Safety and Design Review Committee (NSDRC) concerning the clarity of the suggested Specification, we felt it necessary to rewrite the Reactor Coolant Vent Specifications in the form attached. This matter was discussed with your staff, as was the additional time required to respond. We believe the intent of the T/S suggested by Generic Letter 83-37 has been fully met with the attached redrafted Specification.

We also note that the addition of the new Specifications will require some indexing changes, which are not included at this time. However, these changes will be submitted with the balance of Generic Letter 83-37 Technical Specifications.

The results of the change are within criteria as defined by the NRC in Item II.B.1 of NUREG-0737 and in the attached Basis to this Technical Specification. Although the change proposed by this letter may result in some increase in the probability or consequences of a previously analyzed accident, or may reduce in some way a safety margin, the results of the change are clearly within the above cited acceptable criteria. Therefore, on the basis of the above, we concluded that these changes will not involve a significant hazards consideration as defined in 10 CFR 50.92.


These proposed changes have been reviewed by the Plant Nuclear Safety Review Committee (PNSRC) and the Nuclear Safety and Design Review Committee (NSDRC).

In compliance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.91(b)(1), a copy of this letter and its attachment have been transmitted to Mr. R. C. Callen of the Michigan Public Service Commission.

Since these proposed changes involve a single safety issue for two identical units, we interpret 10 CFR 170.22 as requiring a fee of \$4,400. As such, please find enclosed a check for the above specified amount.
