This letter is in reference to our letter of March 30, 1984 (AEP:NRC:0838B) which was in response to the July 8, 1983 Generic Letter 83-28. Subsequent to our March 30, 1984 submittal, it was discovered that the name we had chosen for the program to control vendor documents (VENDOR DOCUMENT CONTROL SYSTEM - VDCS) was already in use for another program within our company. Therefore, we are changing the name of this program as follows:

In the fourth paragraph of our March 30, 1984 cover letter (AEP:NRC:0838B) and throughout Attachment III to that letter, the term VENDOR DOCUMENT CONTROL SYSTEM OR VDCS is to be changed to VENDOR INFORMATION CONTROL SYSTEM (VICS).
