Dear Mr. Denton:


A member of your staff has requested us to commit to placing the Fire Protection Program into the FSAR as proposed in Generic Letter (GL) 86-10.

We are conducting an extensive review of the proposal to place the entire Fire Protection Program, including the Technical Specifications, into the FSAR. Our initial review of the concept is favorable. However, during discussions with another utility which is licensed under this concept, several problems were revealed. The problems centered around the lack of clear definitions concerning NRC reports and reportable conditions and/or events.

In light of these problems we are not prepared to commit to the plan at this time. We will continue our review of the GL 86-10 proposal to place all Fire Protection Programs into the FSAR.

This letter has been prepared following Corporate procedures which incorporate a reasonable set of controls to insure its accuracy and completeness prior to signature by the undersigned.
