Dear Dr. Murley:

This letter is in response to the March 7, 1989 letter from Mr. Edward L. Jordan, Director, Office for Analysis and Evaluation of Operational Data. Mr. Jordan's letter requested our voluntary participation in the Emergency Response Data System (ERDS) implementation at the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant.

We have examined the computer environment at the Cook Nuclear Plant with regard to the general requirements of ERDS which were outlined in Mr. Jordan's correspondence. Our existing systems cannot accomplish the data transmission requirements without extensive modification and upgrade.

Work is currently proceeding to develop a long range plan for the process computer systems to determine what changes will be necessary over the next three to five years. The progress and evolution of the ERDS program will be monitored and included as an important consideration in the formation of future plans. We would like to maintain an open dialogue with the NRC but defer participation until such time when we may be in a better position to adapt our systems to ERDS requirements.

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
