Attachment 1 to the referenced letter describes a potential leakage path from primary containment to secondary containment caused by a deficiency in the design of four RHR relief valves. As corrective action, the Supply System has decided to deactivate operation of the RHR system in the steam condensing mode and remove the subject valves. This mode of operation is infrequently used and credit is not taken for its operation in the WNP-2 FSAR Chapter 15 accident analysis.

Deactivation of this mode of operation represents no obstacle in the safe operation of WNP-2.
