Dear Mr. Denton:

This letter is in response to an item in the Safety Evaluation (SE) attached to Mr. Steven A. Varga's letter dated August 31, 1983. The SE stated that the RCS vent system design is acceptable provided certain items were resolved. One of the items involved the restoration of continuous control power to the RCS vent system by deleting the commitment to rack out the related circuit breakers during normal operation. Continuous power is needed for vent valve position indication in the control room.

Pursuant to the requirements of your staff as presented in the SE, we hereby withdraw our commitment to rack out the RCS vent system breakers during normal operation.

This document has been prepared following Corporate procedures which incorporate a reasonable set of controls to insure its accuracy and completeness prior to signature by the undersigned.
