This letter confirms a commitment made by Mr. Jack Hays to Mr. Ted Verdery of your staff on October 9, 1978, and responds to your letter dated October 13, 1978. As noted by Mr. Hays, Florida Power & Light Company has agreed to ensure that there are three (3) individuals on site at all times at Turkey Point who have received fire fighting training in accordance with the existing Turkey Point Fire Protection Training Program. This agreement was put into effect at Turkey Point on October 13, 1978.

In response to your position as stated in the enclosure to your letter of October 13, Florida Power & Light Company will incorporate respiratory protection training in accordance with the Turkey Point Health Physics Program in the training program for the three-man fire brigade by November 1, 1978. Since this training will be accomplished as an integral part of the scheduled operator requalification training, we expect that several individuals from each shift complement will be certified in respiratory protection, including the three-man fire brigade members. However, in the unlikely event that a fire brigade member is required in an emergency situation to enter an area with high airborne activity without having first been fully certified in respiratory protection in accordance with the Health Physics Program, the individual will still be afforded the appropriate respiratory protection. His lack of certification will be taken into account in estimating his internal exposure in accordance with 10 CFR 103(c).
