

Industry Notes for Regulatory Issues Task Force Meeting

November 7, 2017

- The industry appreciates the improving trend in the timeliness of closing licensing actions. It is helpful for licensees in planning from a budget and implementation perspective, and is the result of good communication and process changes driven by a learning organization.
- We look forward to the NRC's Operating Reactors Performance Dashboard going live at the end of 2017 or early in 2018. Not only will this dashboard, in combination with the industry's proposed dashboard, give us insights into behaviors and results, but the ability to access the underlying data set will allow for quicker identification and resolution of declining trends or problem areas.
- The industry is appreciative of the opportunity to address CRGR relative to the draft service life RIS, and we strongly believe the staff should act on CRGR's recommendation to discontinue development of the RIS. We understand that inspector training materials are under development, with the intention of a public workshop to discuss the content of that training prior to implementation. Because this training will directly influence the closure of existing unresolved items and set the tone for inspections moving forward, it is important that the guidance be technically accurate, durable, and not subject to the same backfitting concerns represented by the draft RIS.
