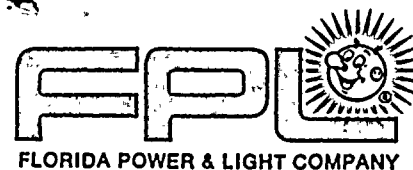

Grid Voltage Information Request

On July 30, 1979 we received your letter requesting that Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) provide additional information on grid voltage at Turkey Point Units 3 and 4. Shortly thereafter, on August 13, 1979, we received a letter from Mr. William Gammill of the NRC Division of Operating Reactors that also requested information about the FPL distribution system. The time frame for responding to Mr. Gammill's letter is early October, 1979.

To permit the most efficient use of our manpower, we are reviewing the two requests in parallel and plan to respond to them within the same time frame. Therefore, we have scheduled October 8, 1979 as the common date for submitting our responses.
