AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-46

AMENDMENT NO. 11

Effective May 1, 1977, Indemnity Agreement No. B-46, between Florida Power & Light Company, and the Atomic Energy Commission, dated August 4, 1970, as amended, is hereby further amended by modifying the prefatory language of paragraph 5, Article I, to read as follows:
