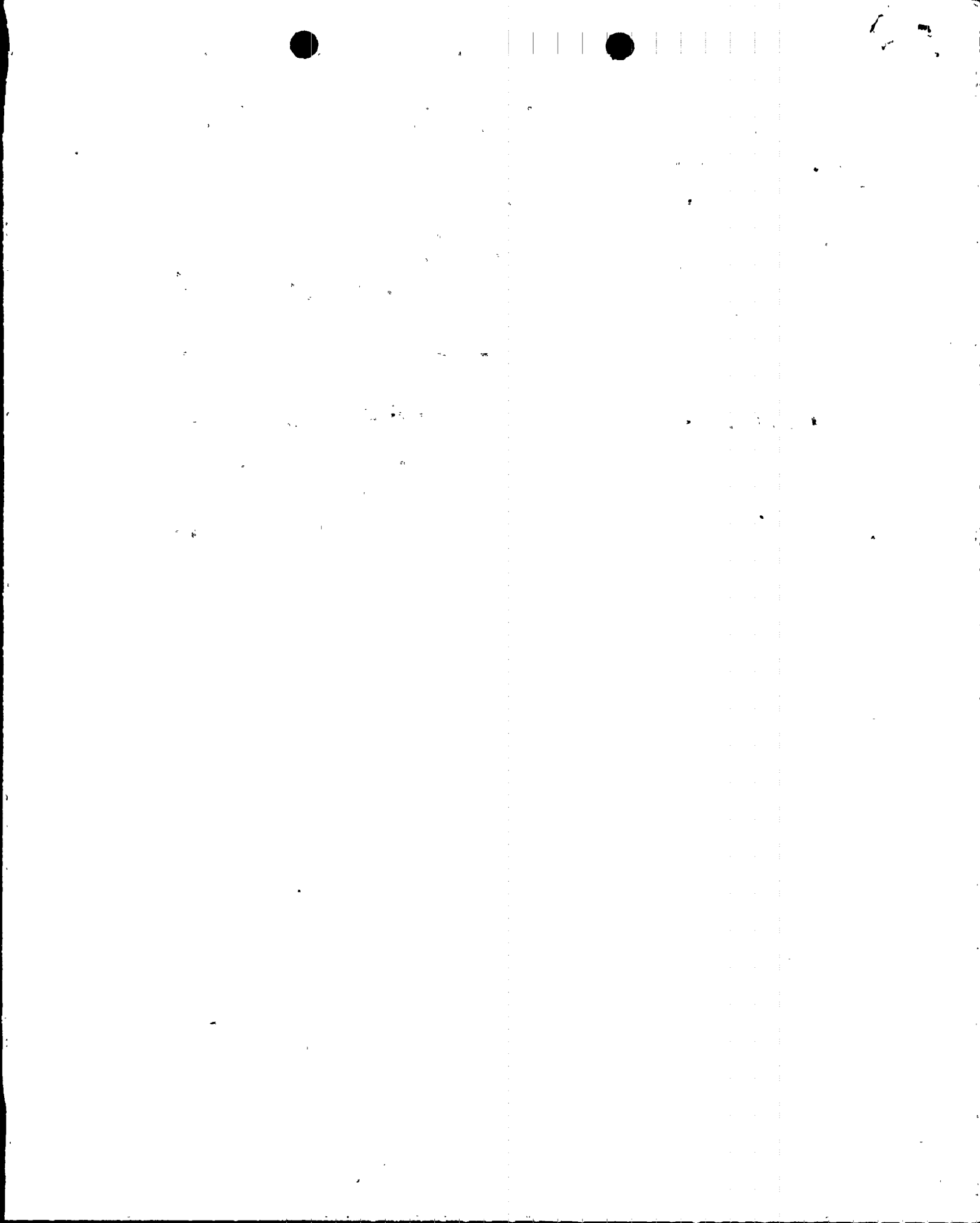

I should like very much to be allowed to make some comments at that Hearing.

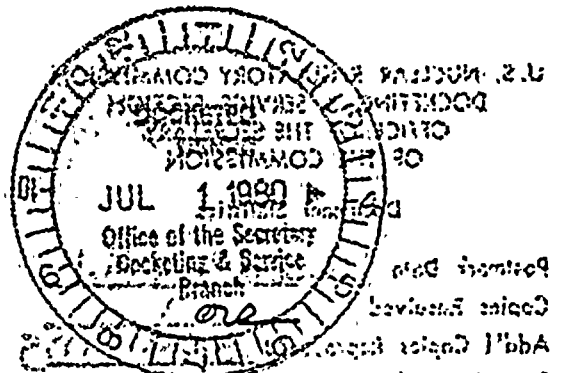
I am not an employee nor stockholder of FP&L or Westinghouse, nor do I belong to any anti-nuclear or environmental groups.

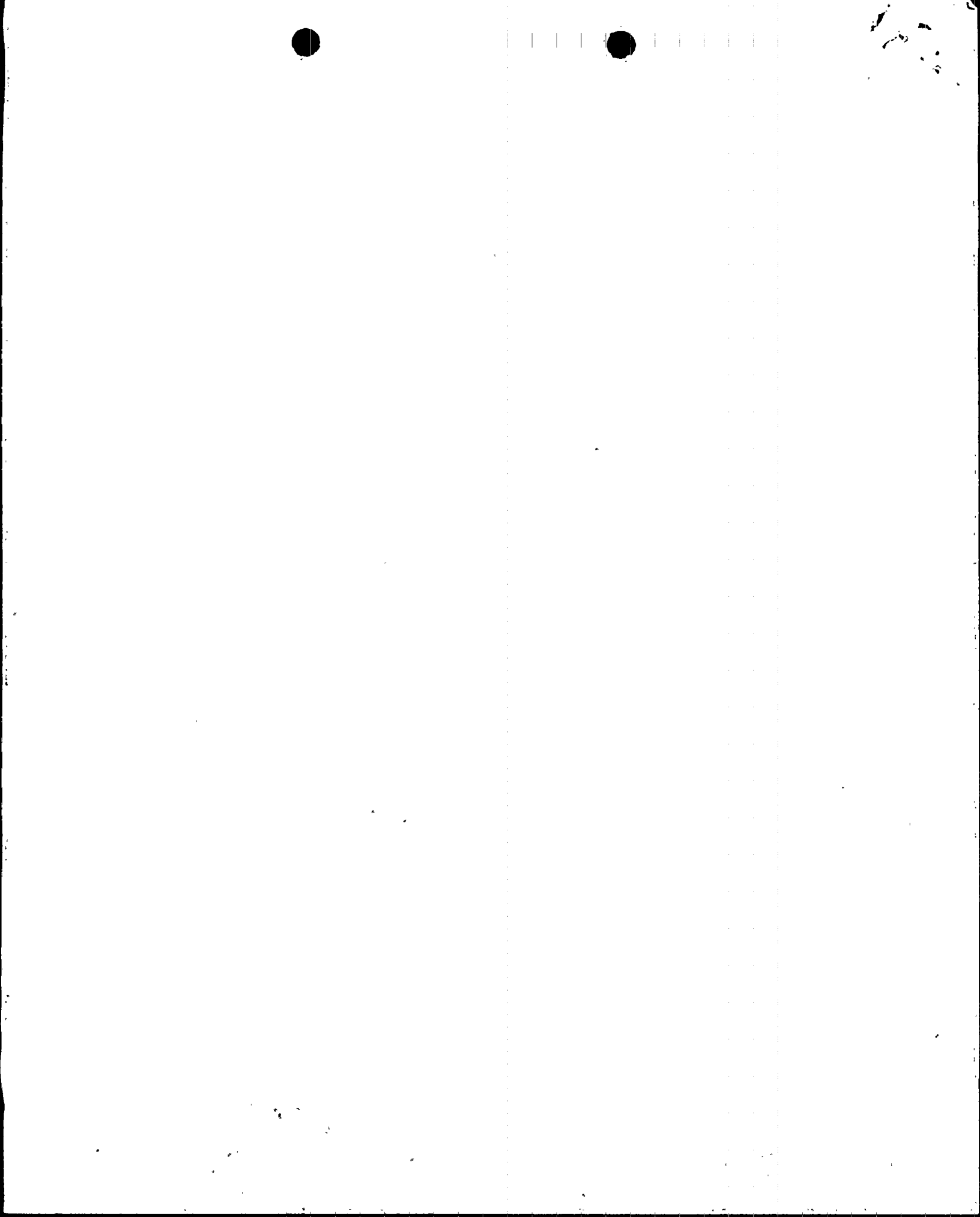

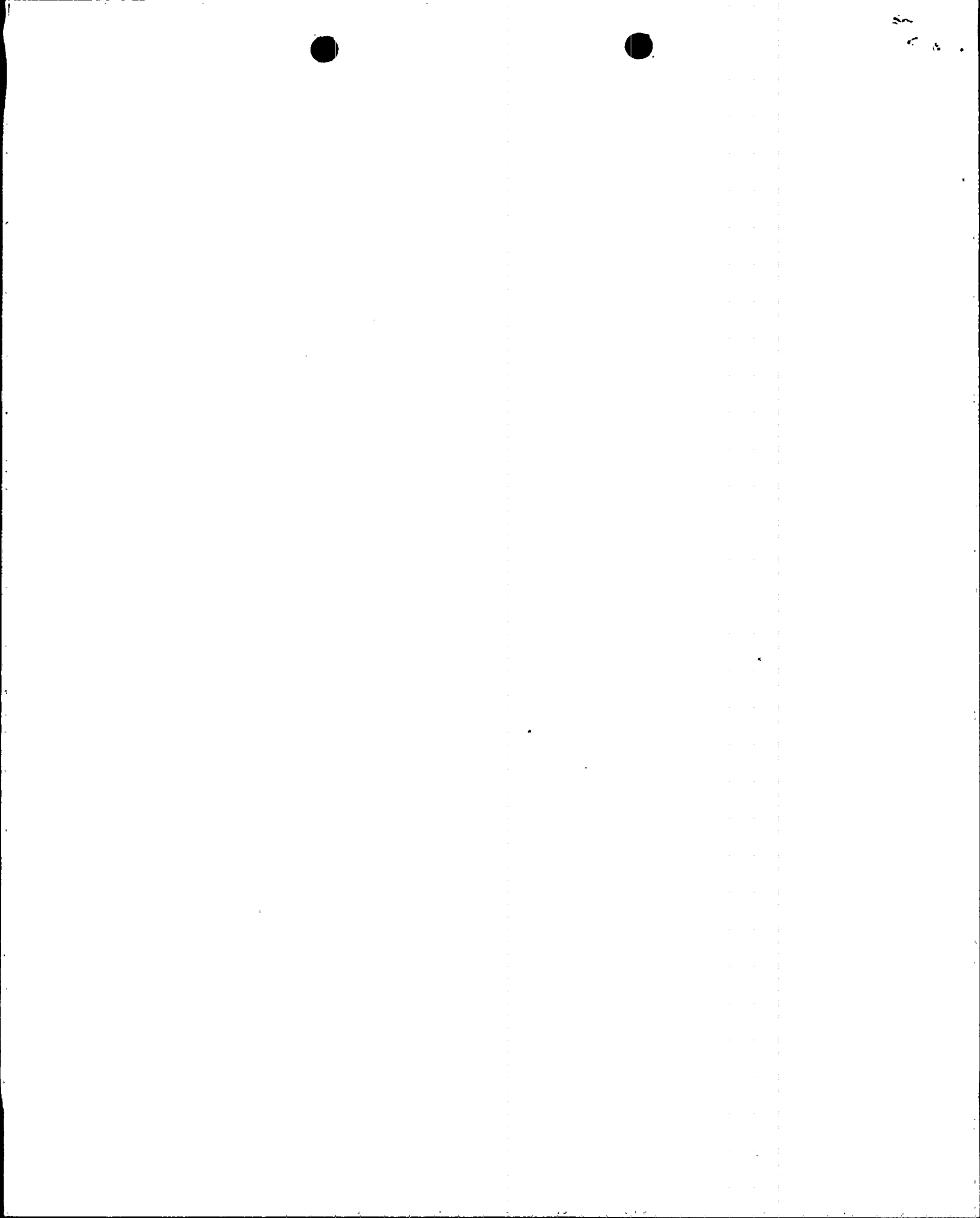
