

Senator Stone:

As I am sure you are aware
Florida Power & Light has prob-
lems with their nuclear re-
actors NO. 3 and NO. 4 at
Turkey Point, just south of
Miami.

Because of defective tubing,
leaking of steam and corrosion;
these will be replaced at a
cost of some \$500-\$600 million
dollars in the near future.

I am concerned that the
customers of FP&L will have to
shoulder the burden of this cost
of replacement and repair.

I am also concerned about the problems associated with the radiation and exposure to the surrounding environment of effluents which may escape as a result of this massive undertaking.

There is further, the problem of long term storage of on site radioactive waste materials.

Since nuclear power technology has become increasingly suspect as being economically feasible and safe to operate, I believe it has become incumbent upon FPIC to show some public concern to the So. Florida area.

I therefore request you to urge FPIC to publish an evacuation plan to those customers living in a 40 radius of Turkey Point.

And to include a copy of

the evacuation instructions with the electric bill at least once a year.

I toured the Turkey Point facility when it was under construction. I was concerned then about the advisability of pursuing nuclear power as an energy source, and all the attendant problems thereto.

The potential dangers still worry me.

What is your view of what we, as concerned Floridians, can do to ensure our continued safety; both to us as individuals, and to that of our environment?

What efforts have you taken and will undertake to make sure Turkey Point does not become an unwarranted economic burden on the cus-

orners of FP&C, and to see
that our safety is secured, and
that our future is not en-
dangered because plans are
not made now so that a
catastrophe does not happen
at some time down the road?

We are playing with a time-
bomb, and we need to enact
plans, and seriously consider
alternatives to defuse the
possible harm presented by
our imprudence now.

Your suggestions and com-
ments on how we can work
to a solution will be most
appreciated.
