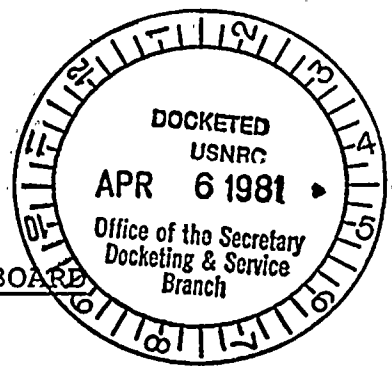

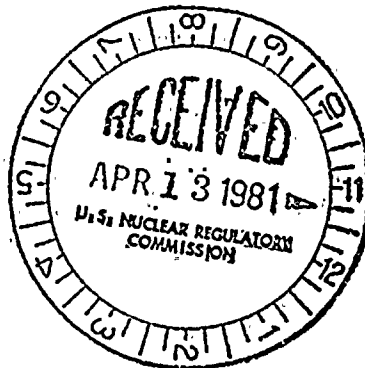

LICENSEE'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY
DISPOSITION OF CONTENTION 5

Pursuant to 10 CFR §2.749, Florida Power & Light Company
("FPL" or "Licensee") moves for summary disposition, in its
favor, of Contention 5, which provides:

In evaluating the steam generator repair,
the following has not been considered:

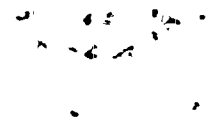
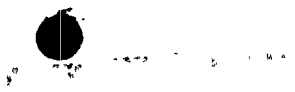
- a. the cost of a full-flow condensate
polishing demineralizing system;
- b. the effluent release from a full-flow
condensate polishing demineralizing system;
or
- c. the environmental degradation caused by
a full-flow condensate polishing demineraliz-
ing system.



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The grounds for this motion are that, as to the matters raised in this contention, there exists no genuine issue of material fact and that Licensee is entitled to a favorable decision as a matter of law.

An affidavit, a statement of the material facts as to which there is no genuine issue, and a memorandum of law in support of this motion are attached.
