LICENSEE'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY
DISPOSITION OF CONTENTION 8

Pursuant to 10 CFR § 2.749, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL" or "Licensee") moves for summary disposition, in its favor, of Contention 8.

Contention 8 states:

The proposed method of radiation monitoring during repair of the steam generators will not provide accurate information to comply with 10 CFR Parts 20 and 50.


