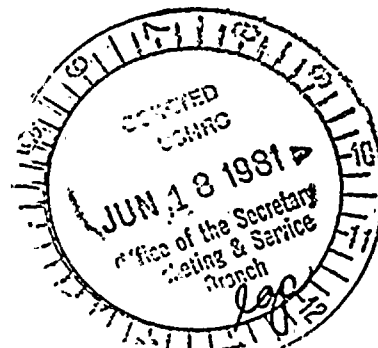

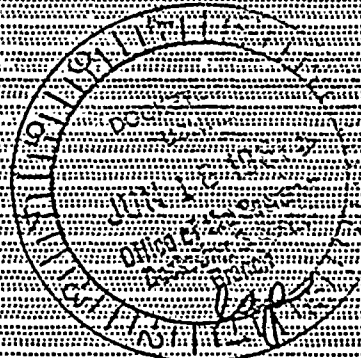

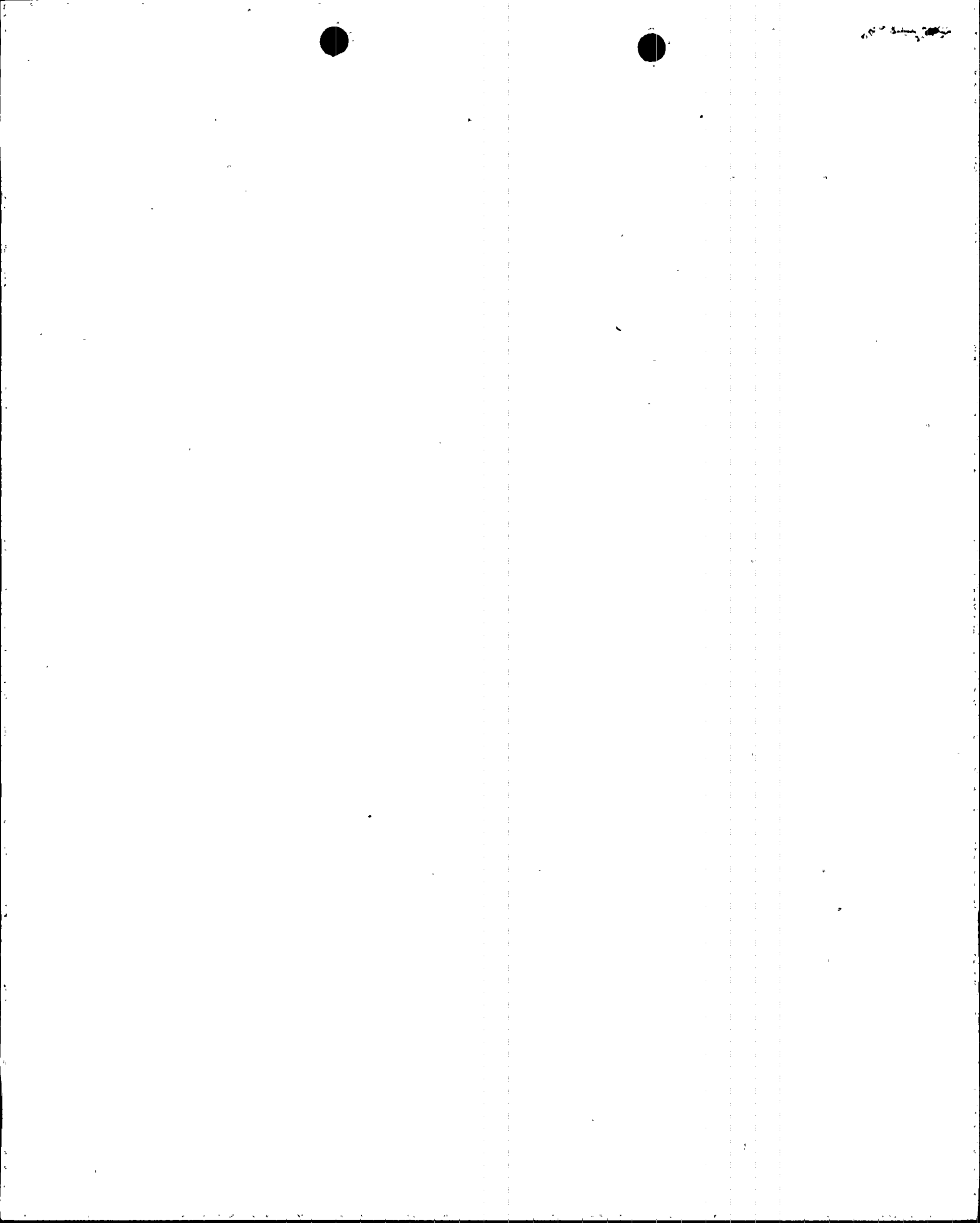
Dear Senator Chiles:

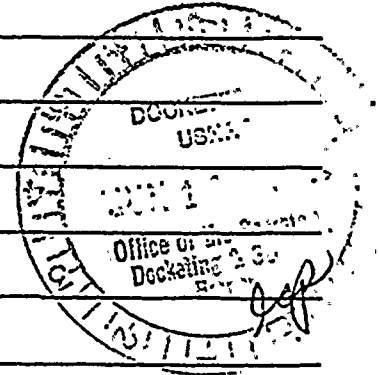

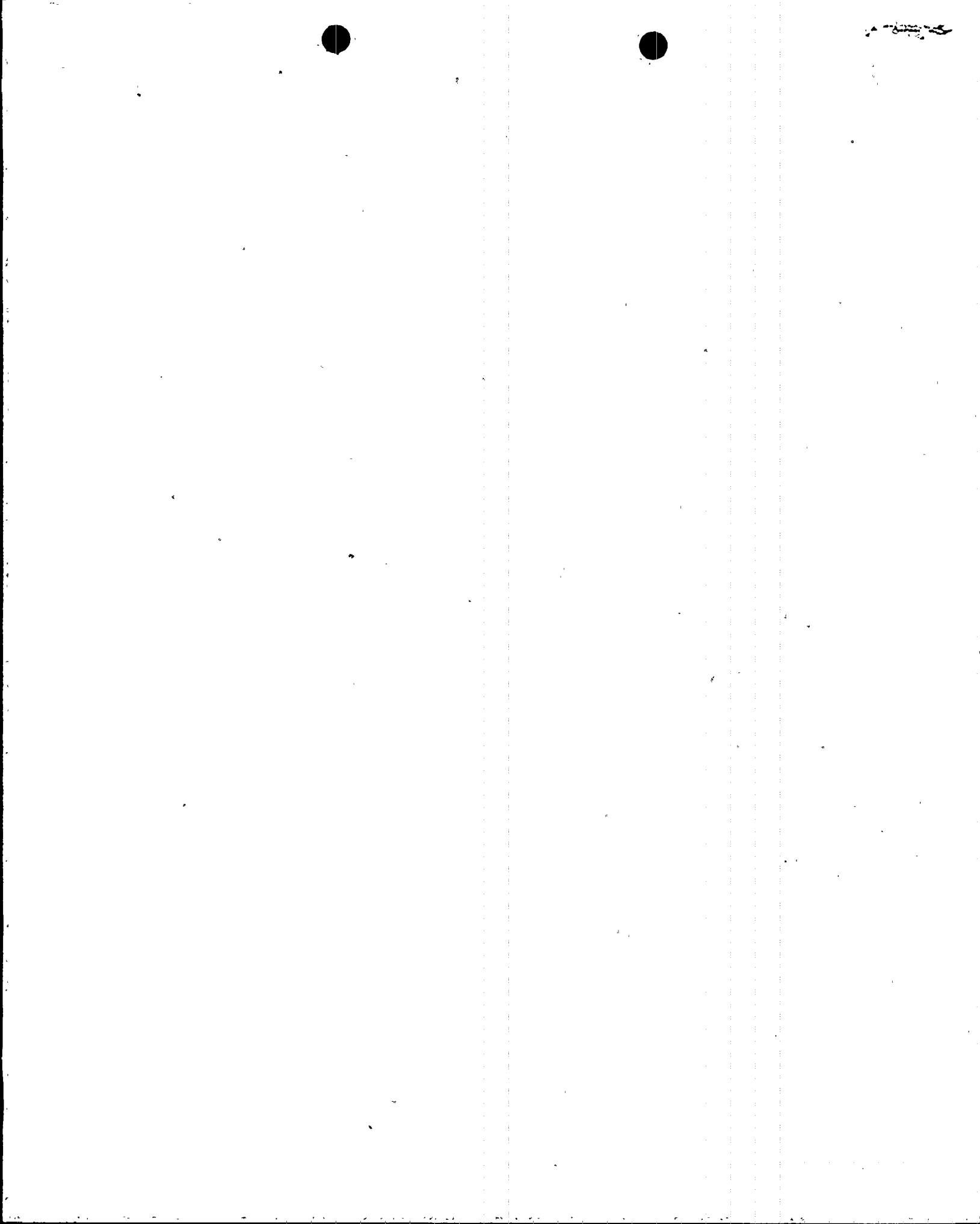
