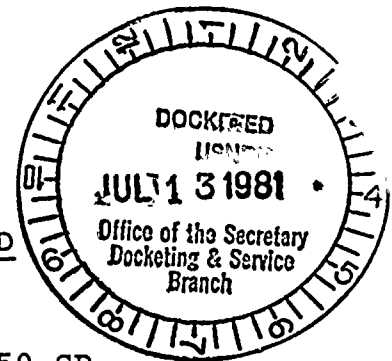

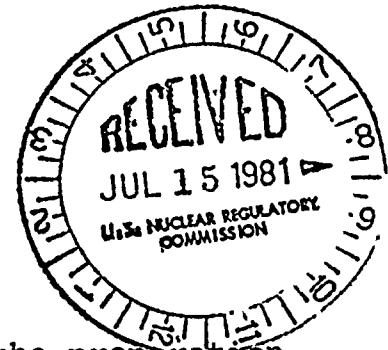

FINAL ORDER

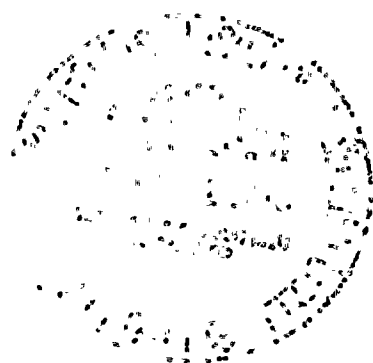


On Friday, July 10, 1981, subsequent to the preparation of "Licensee's Answer in Opposition to Intervenor's Application for Stay of Final Order", counsel for Licensee received by mail postmarked July 9, 1981, Intervenor's "Supplement to Application for Stay of Final Order" dated July 8, 1981.

Neither the SGRR, nor any of its supplements, nor the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Final Order dated June 19, 1981 contain any statement or condition ". . . that work was not to begin on the repairs until October 1, 1981."

The work presently being done by Licensee on Unit No. 3 is being done pursuant to and in compliance with the amendments to the Turkey Point Unit No. 3 and Unit No. 4 operating licenses issued by the NRC Staff pursuant to the


