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

ATWS Implementation Schedule

On August 20, 1985 (L-85-308), FPL notified the NRC that a preliminary schedule had been developed for implementation of the modifications required under 10 CFR 50.62 and that based on the schedules it would not be possible to implement the modifications by the Winter of 1986 for Turkey Point Unit 3, nor by the Winter of 1987 for Turkey Point Unit 4 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.62(d) requirements.

FPL is a member of the Westinghouse Owners Group (WOG) and participating in the WOG AMSAC Generic Design Program.

The results of the WOG Program (WCAP-10858 AMSAC Generic Design Package) were transmitted to the NRC for review and approval on July 25, 1985. WOG has recently indicated to FPL that the NRC Safety Evaluation Report (SER) is not planned to be issued until Mid-November.

FPL needs to evaluate the impact of the SER on each of the designs described in WCAP-10858 in order to determine which logic is best suited for the Turkey Point Units and when it can be installed.

FPL will provide NRC the Turkey Point schedule to comply with the ATWS rule 90 days after the SER on WCAP-10858 is issued.
