Nuclear Organization Changes

Effective February 1, 1988, Mr. William F. Conway will assume the duties of Senior Vice President-Nuclear for Florida Power & Light Company. This appointment is in conjunction with an organization change which will have the Site Vice Presidents for the Turkey Point and St. Lucie Plants and the Vice President Nuclear Energy reporting directly to Mr. Conway. All the Nuclear Energy Department staff groups will now report to Mr. J. W. Dickey, Vice President Nuclear Energy. The revised offsite organization is shown by the attached figure which will be submitted in the near future with our request for license amendments to modify the respective plant Technical Specifications.

Because an amendment cannot be submitted and approved before the effective date of Mr. Conway's assignment, we request that the NRC grant relief from the requirements of the current Turkey Point and St. Lucie Technical Specifications dealing with the offsite organization. We have concluded that these changes will certainly have no negative affect on the health and safety of the public. It is our wish to withhold submittal of these amendment requests until Mr. Conway is available to review these and other required changes affecting the Company Nuclear Review Board. ; -



In addition, we expect Mr. Conway to perform a key role in the resolution of problems identified by the independent management appraisal now in progress at Turkey Point. Accordingly, we request Paragraph V.D. of the NRC Order dated October 19, 1987 (EA 87-85) to be modified to appoint Mr. Conway to the senior level review board in addition to the current members. The board would, therefore, consist of the FPL Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, the President and Chief Operations Officer, the Executive Vice President and the Senior Vice President-Nuclear. Paragraph V.F. of the same order grants the Regional Administrator authority to make changes in the provisions of the order.

As Executive Vice President, I will, of course, remain active in overseeing our nuclear activities.

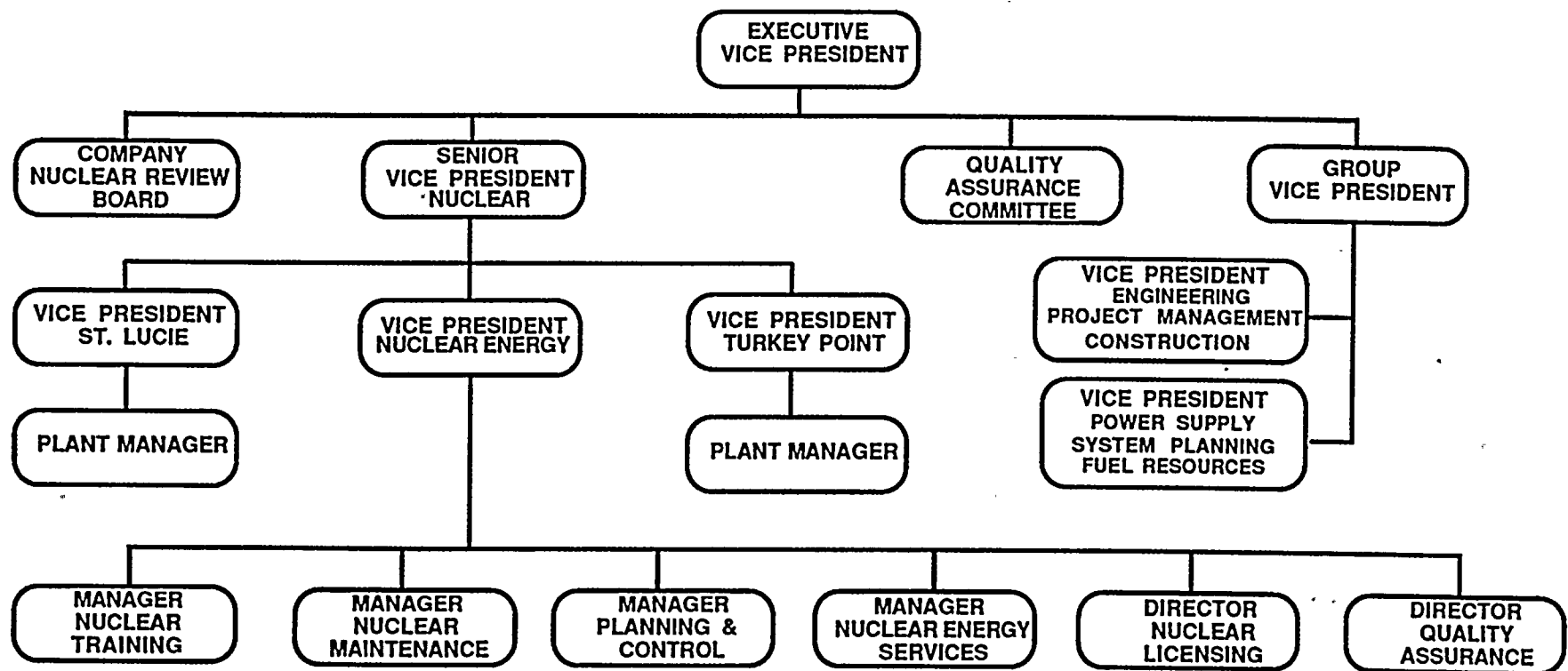
