Nuclear Organization Changes

In a letter, L-88-23, dated January 15, 1988, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) requested relief from the offsite organization Technical Specifications for Turkey Point and St. Lucie Plants in order to implement changes in the organization of the Nuclear Energy Department. Following discussions with the NRC Staff, FPL decided to maintain the current Technical Specification organization and submit license amendments for each site to facilitate the organization change. As a result of this decision, the relief requested in our letter is no longer required. Accordingly, FPL withdraws its request for relief.

In our January 15, 1988 letter we also requested that Paragraph V.D. of the NRC Order dated October 19, 1987 (EA 87-85) be revised. The purpose of this proposed revision was to have allowed participation in the activities of the review board by an additional member of senior FPL management. Based on further discussions with the NRC Region II Staff, we understand that the participation of additional FPL management personnel in the activities of the senior level review board is acceptable to the NRC without a revision of the order. Because this allowance for expanded participation in the board currently exists, we have no immediate need to revise the section of the order which specifies the senior level review board membership. It is our understanding that it would be appropriate to resubmit our request to revise the

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composition of the senior level review board following the approval of our requested amendment and implementation of our proposed reorganization.
