Dear Chairman Zech:


Enclosed please find four letters addressed to Congressman Fascell but referred to me regarding the Turkey Point Plant.

I would be appreciative if you could address the concerns of my constituents with regard to the safety of the Turkey Point Plant. Please respond back to me.


