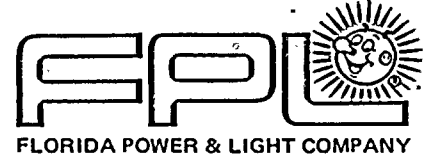

In the effort to actuate the proposed arrangement between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and Florida Power & Light Company regarding the storage of nuclear plant licensing records, we have reviewed considerations which affect this recommendation.

Based on FERC and NRC requirements, FPL standards and discussions between Mr. Dennis Morgan and Mr. R. Stephen Scott, some trial implementation actions, as mutually agreed, can be addressed. With this assurance, we could be confident that duplicity has been established and that both FERC and FPL access to records can be accomplished. We will arrange a visit with your Mr. R. Scott in order to review details of the NRC records receipt and storage system.

Once again, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your positive response to our proposal as well as your assistance in resolving these concerns.

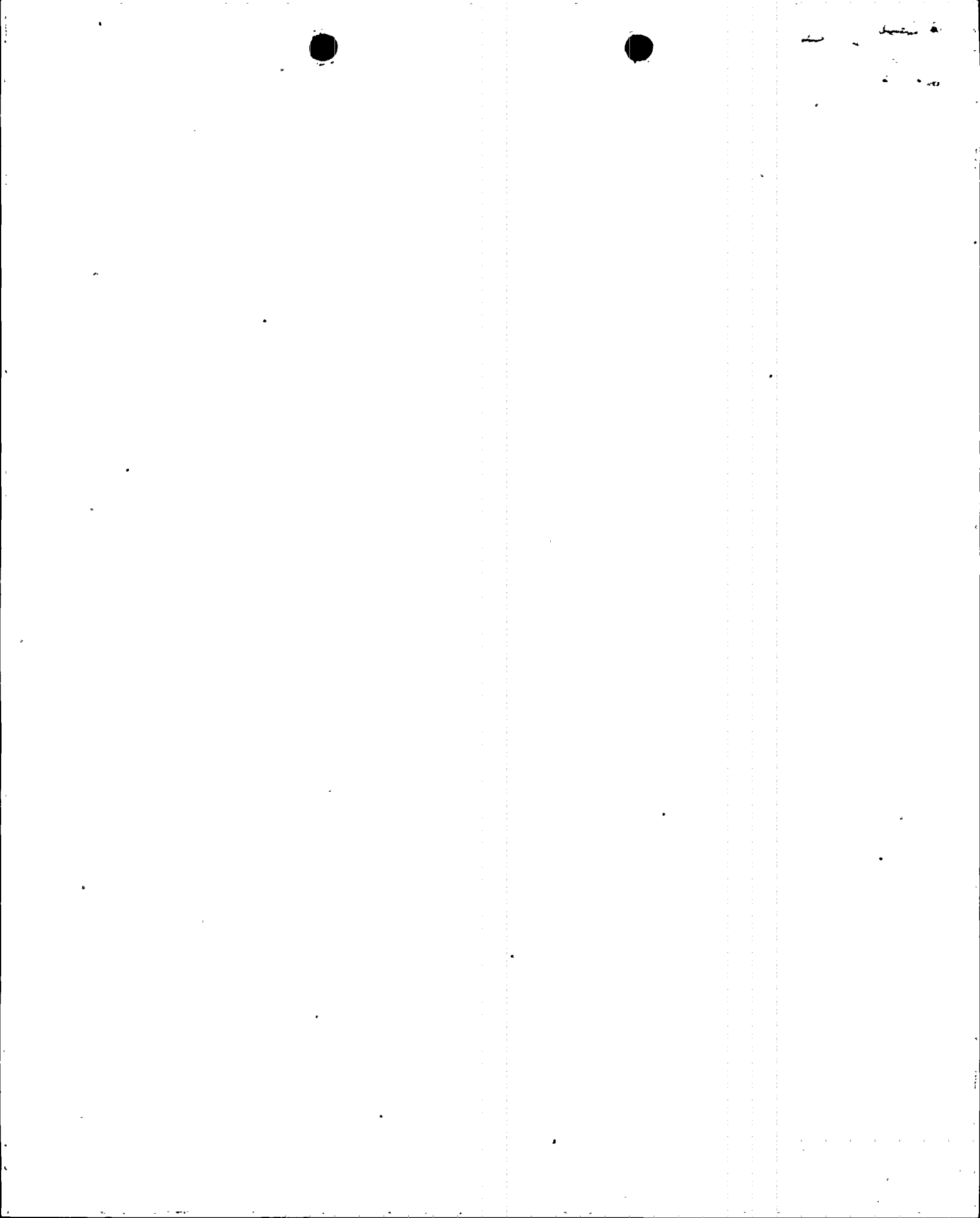

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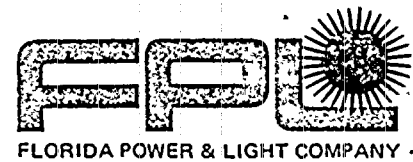
