In accordance with 10 CFR 50.90, Florida Power & Light Company submits herewith three signed originals and forty copies of a request to amend Appendix A of Facility Operating Licenses DPR-31 and 41.

This amendment is submitted to consolidate all previous submittals (L-81-206, dated May-14, 1981 and L-82-244, dated June 10, 1982) regarding safety-related snubbers, and to provide an update to Table 3.13-1 to include additional snubbers installed since the last submittals.

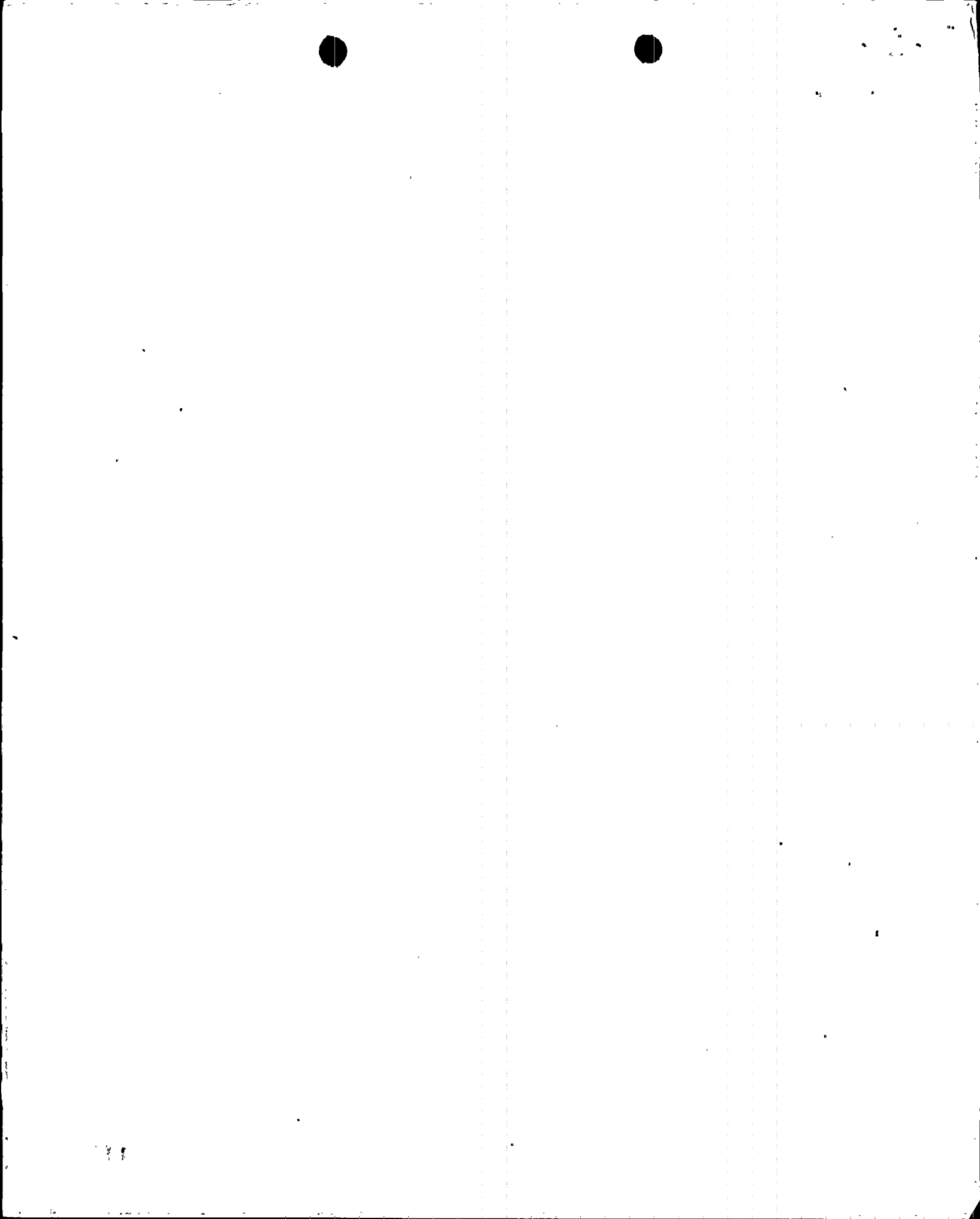
The Table has been expanded to include all safety-related snubbers installed since the previous submittals.


These submittals are the results of NRC requests and represent incorporation of the previously approved standard Technical Specifications into the Turkey Point Unit 3 and 4 Technical Specification format. Therefore, we have determined that this proposed Amendment does not pose a Significant Hazard as defined by 10 CFR 50.92 in that it does not:

1. Involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously evaluated; or
2. Create the possibility of a new or different kind of accident from any accident previously evaluated; or
3. Involve a significant reduction in a margin of safety.

The proposed amendment has been reviewed by the Turkey Point Units 3 & 4 Plant Nuclear Safety Committee and the Florida Power & Light Company Nuclear Review Board.

It has been determined that this amendment represents a Class I and III amendment and that in accordance with 10 CFR 170.22 payment of \$4,400 is due. Our records indicate that we have made overpayments for a total of \$8,800 for this amendment (see letters June 29, 1981, L-81-265 and June 17, 1982, L-82-252). Please advise us how we can correct this error.
