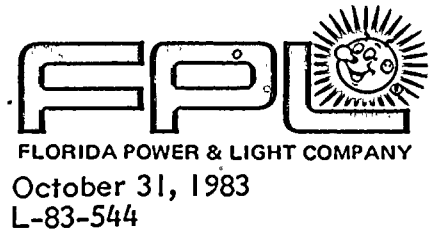

By letter dated July 15, 1983 (L-83-406), FPL submitted a preliminary spent fuel storage facility expansion report. The purpose of this preliminary report was twofold: 1) To inform the NRC that FPL was preparing to rerack Turkey Point Units 3 & 4 spent fuel pools and would need NRC review and concurrence, and 2) to provide the NRC with enough information to make an initial determination that no significant hazard considerations existed. In your letter of September 13, 1983, the NRC concluded that inadequate information had been provided in the July 15 report and stated that additional information would be required by the NRC in order to make a significant hazards determination.

The July 15 submittal originally scheduled a revised report for November 1, 1983 to provide the vendor specific information regarding rerack design. Since the purchase order award was significantly delayed, the information for the revised report will not be ready in November. As such, FPL hereby withdraws the July 15, 1983 Amendment Request and accompanying Safety Analysis Report. A complete report will be prepared for submittal by March 31, 1984.
