FOR INFORMATION OF THE BUREAU, THE FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY OF THE INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM THE ALGERIAN ARMY IN NEW YORK ON OCTOBER 10, 1950:

1. The Algerian Army in New York is composed of approximately 1,000 men, organized into three battalions. The first battalion is composed of approximately 300 men, the second of approximately 350 men, and the third of approximately 350 men.

2. The Algerian Army in New York is currently engaged in training exercises. The exercises are being conducted in the area of New York City and are being supervised by the Algerian Army in New York.

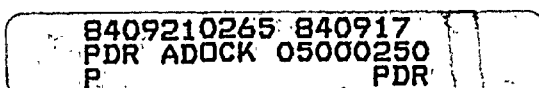
