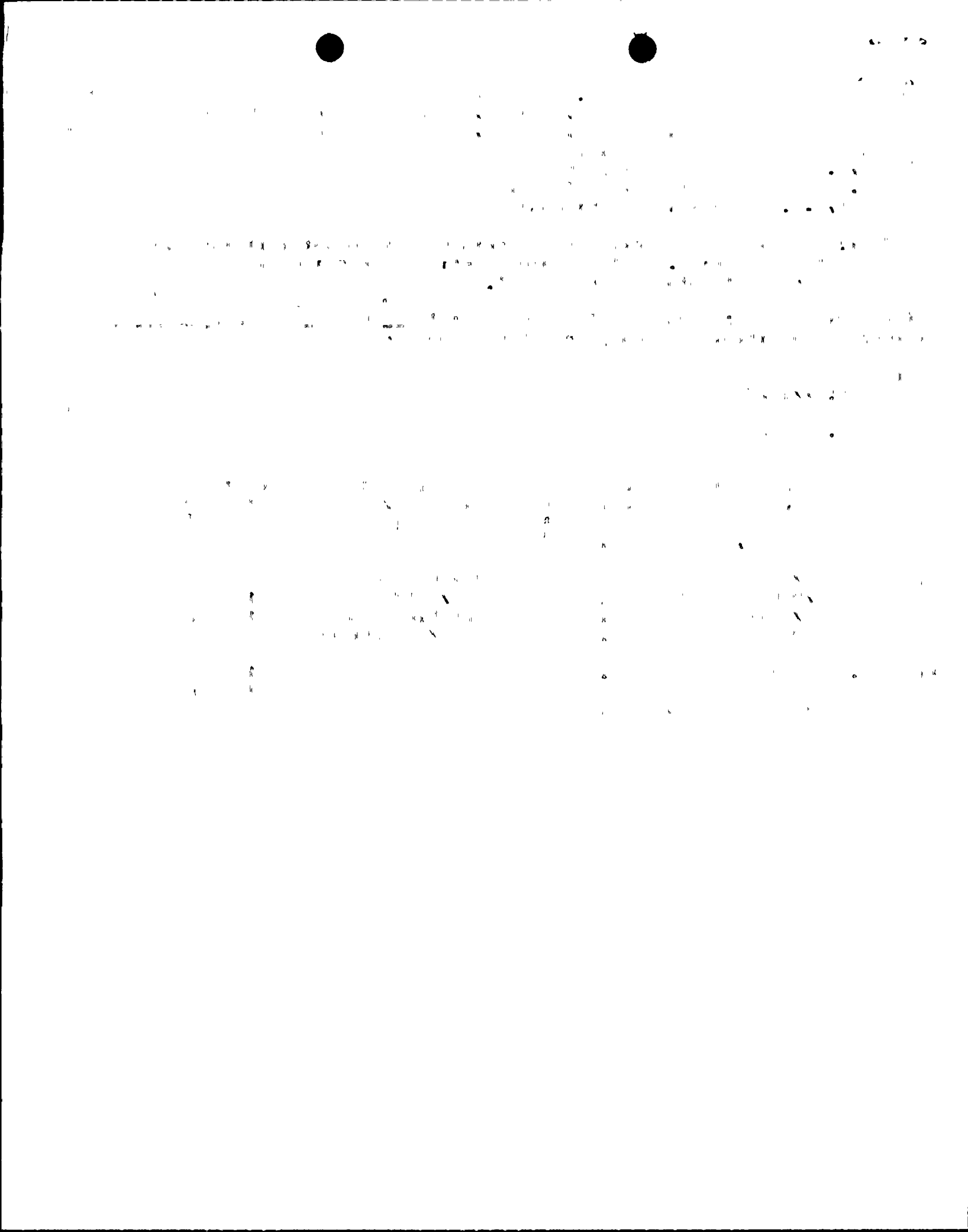

Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

We received notice 7590-01 regarding the frequency and date of exercises for the Turkey Point Plant operated by Florida Power & Light Company in Dade County, Florida.

Dade County has on numerous occasions requested the exercises for Turkey Point be conducted in the January to March period. This year we agreed to the November date with the verbal understanding from the State of Florida and utility that subsequent exercises would be held in January - March. Our request to Florida Power and Light Company and the State of Florida is not reflected in your notice, in that it appears approval has been quanted for continuing November exercises (Federal Register, Vol. 49, No. 189).

While June was objectionable as the beginning of the hurricane season, November is far worse because the planning time for the exercise occurs during our peak times of vulnerability (September 15 to October 15). This years November date was a one time concession by the County to accomodate the state and utility due to the combined federal exercise at St. Lucie last March. Please note our objection to exercises that do not fall into the January to March period.
