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

Reconstitution of Design Basis

Engineering review and comment promulgation on revised versions of the reconstituted design bases are essentially complete. Resolution of comments is in progress.

Design verification procedures and criteria are being developed.

Walkdowns

One hundred and sixty-one (161) small bore piping and tubing walkdowns are complete.

One hundred and twenty-six (126) breaker list walkdowns are complete.

One hundred and ten (110) P&ID walkdowns are complete.
