This is in response to your letter of February 1, 1989, requesting input to assist the Commission in its response to a petition filed by Mr. Thomas Saporito under 10 CFR 2.206, with respect to the Turkey Point facility, dated December 21, 1988, as supplemented on January 13, 1989.


FPL welcomes the opportunity to furnish such information and to cooperate in any way with the Commission's review of this matter. In order to provide assistance, however, with regard to that part of the petition alleging "willfull falsification and destruction of Safety Related Plant documents" and related allegations, as reflected in a deposition which Mr. Saporito states was taken by the NRC on January 12, 1989 (see supplement to petition, January 13, 1989), FPL will require access to that deposition. We understand that the deposition may have to be reviewed and, if necessary, edited to protect identities of individuals or for other

We are nevertheless vitally interested in investigating and furnishing such information as may be helpful to the Commission in addressing this aspect of the petition, even if we must rely on less than a full text. Accordingly, we request a copy of, or access to, Mr. Saporito's deposition of January 12, 1989, under such conditions, if any, as the Commission may impose.
