Effective January 1, 1991, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) will no longer be testing for barbiturates, benzodiazepines, and methaqualone, as previously submitted in FPL letter L-90-01 dated January 2, 1990. Analysis of preaccess and random drug test results since 1985 indicates that there is no reason to continue to test for these three drugs. In addition, there is also no indication that these additional drugs are a problem in the geographical areas where our workforce lives.

FPL will continue to test for the substances required under 10 CFR 26 Appendix A.2.1 (a) as indicated in the attachment. Our cut-off levels for amphetamines (300 ng/ml) and cannabinoids (50 ng/ml) in initial tests and for cannabinoids (10 ng/ml) and opiates (200 ng/ml) in confirmatory tests will remain the same, exceeding those specified by the NRC.
