These changes consisted of reorganization of procedural steps for a Site Area Emergency, addition of sigma theta and delta T information, and performance of release calculations during any release. EPIP 20104 has been updated to reflect enhanced notification instructions. EPIP 20110 has been updated to clarify evacuation criteria and to provide more readable maps. EPIP 20127 has been updated to correct position titles and to provide more readable maps. EPIPs 20113 and 20119 have been cancelled, with the information incorporated into a plant administrative procedure.
