STATEMENT OF INTENT

As Deputy Commissioner for Operations/COO of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), I exercise express authority and responsibility to request from FDA funds for decommissioning activities associated with the operations authorized by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Material License No. 20-08361-01. This authority is established by FDA Staff Manual Guide 1410.21. Within this authority, I intend to request that funds be made available when necessary in the amount of \$1,907,433 to decommission The Department of Health and Human Services, Food and Drug Administration, Winchester Engineering and Analytical Center, 109 Holton Street, Winchester, MA, 01890.

I intend to request and obtain these funds sufficiently in advance of decommissioning to prevent delay of required activities.
