## MANAGEMENT ACTIONS

### TURKEY POINT PLANT

#### **Toxicology Laboratory Actions**

Florida Power & Light contracted Fitness for Duty Toxicological service with Eagle Laboratories starting on January 30, 1993. During that time, there were several samples (twelve) that the laboratory did not report results to the MRO within the 5 day time frame. The decision was made to terminate the contract on March 5, 1993. Turkey Point subsequently contracted toxicology services with Doctors and Physicians Laboratory.

## MANAGEMENT ACTIONS

### ST. LUCIE PLANT

#### **Fitness for Duty Reportable Event**

On May 3, 1993, a confirmed positive random test result was received on a supervisor for Marijuana at 66 ng/ml. Telephone notification to the NRC was made at 1415 hours on May 3, 1993. A review was conducted, with negative results of the Subjects' work activities from February 3, 1993 through May 3, 1993 encompassing all work activities performed during this period.
