The purpose of this letter is to provide a response to NRC Bulletin 96-04.

Turkey Point does not hold and is not an applicant for a certificate of compliance for a transportation cask for commercial spent fuel. Turkey Point does not hold and is not an applicant for a certificate of compliance for a storage cask for commercial spent fuel. Turkey Point is not a vendor of storage or transportation casks for commercial spent fuel. Turkey Point is not a registered user of a transportation cask for commercial spent fuel.

No storage casks for spent fuel are used at Turkey Point and no license application for the use of such a cask is contemplated at this time.

Therefore, Florida Power and Light Co. does not consider Turkey Point as an action addressee as defined in NRC Bulletin 96-04 and no further response is required.

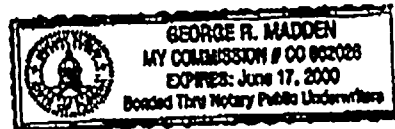
