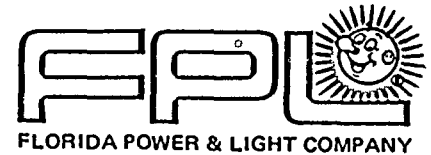

Re: Request for Deletion of the Turkey Point Plant  
Appendix B, Environmental Technical Specifications  
to Operating License Nos. DPR-31 and DPR-41

Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests the deletion of the Turkey Point Plant, Appendix B, Environmental Technical Specifications to Operating License Nos. DPR-31 and DPR-41 which address aquatic monitoring and surveillance requirements. Aquatic chemical, thermal and biotic monitoring aspects are regulated under the Clean Water Act, 1977 as amended, and thus are subject to dual federal regulation if retained in the Environmental Technical Specifications.

Florida Power & Light Company also requests the deletion of the Groundwater Monitoring Program found in the Appendix B, ETS. This program is currently carried out under a joint agreement between Florida Power & Light Company and the South Florida Water Management District, and thus is justifiably addressed only through that agreement.

Be advised that in the near future, Florida Power & Light Company will also be submitting a deletion request for the terrestrial biological monitoring programs at Turkey Point.

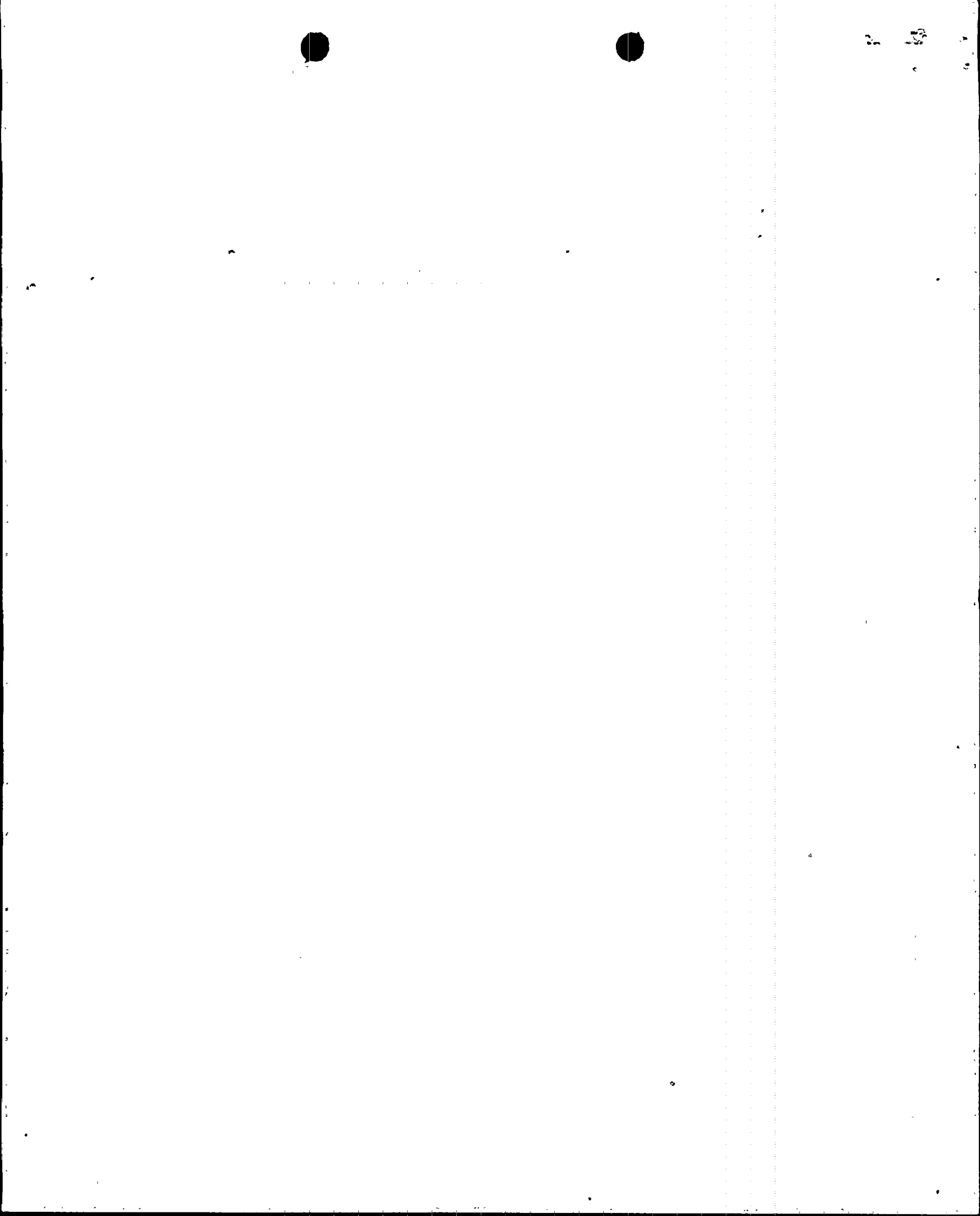

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


