On September 30, 1996, the NRC issued Generic Letter 96-06, "ASSURANCE OF EQUIPMENT OPERABILITY AND CONTAINMENT INTEGRITY DURING DESIGN BASIS ACCIDENT CONDITIONS". The purpose of Generic Letter 96-06 is to:

- (1) notify addressees about safety-significant issues that could affect containment integrity and equipment operability during accident conditions,
- (2) request that all addressees submit certain information relative to the issues that have been identified and implement actions as appropriate to address these issues, and
- (3) require that all addressees submit a written response to the NRC relative to implementation of the requested actions.

Addressees are requested to determine:

- (1) if containment air cooler cooling water systems are susceptible to either waterhammer or two-phase flow conditions during postulated accident conditions,
- (2) if piping systems that penetrate the containment are susceptible to thermal expansion of fluid so that overpressurization of piping could occur.

Addressees are required to submit a written response no later than October 30, 1996, indicating:

- (1) whether or not the requested actions will be completed,
- (2) whether or not the requested information will be submitted, and
- (3) whether or not the requested information will be submitted within the requested time period.

Florida Power and Light will perform the following for Turkey Point Units 3 and 4:

- (1) the requested actions will be completed,
- (2) the requested information will be submitted, and
- (3) the requested information will be submitted no later than January 28, 1997.

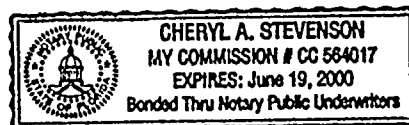
