Based on guidance from the NRC, it is our understanding there is no need to proceed with the import license (IW031).

It is Perma-Fix's intent to revise the submitted export license (XW019) that currently references import license IW031. This revision will state that the waste streams will be imported into the US under a General License as set forth in 10 CFR 110.27.
