Two 24 hour reportable events were reported during this reporting period. First event: On 2-19-97 ,Cocaine residue was found inside a glass tube, with smoke markings, inside a porta-toilet in the Protected Area. Second event :On 4-29-97 ,an FPL Supervisor was tested for cause and was positive for alcohol, results were .084 and .076 .

A review was conducted, with negative results, of the supervisor's work activities for a period of time prior to the test.

**MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:** After the Cocaine residue was found inside the Protected Area, the Random testing percentage increased from the required 50 % to 100% of the plant population for the duration of the outage, which was from 2-21-97 until 4-7-97.
