


MATERIALS LICENSE

This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.



13. The licensee shall conduct a physical inventory every 6 months, or at other intervals approved by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, to account for all sources and/or devices received and possessed under the license. Records of inventories shall be maintained for 3 years from the date of each inventory and shall include the radionuclides, quantities, manufacturer's name and model numbers, and the date of the inventory.
14. Maintenance, repair, cleaning, replacement, and disposal of the device and/or components of the device shall be performed only by the device manufacturer or other persons specifically authorized by the Commission or an Agreement State to perform such services. In addition, the licensee is authorized to perform light maintenance on IsoVac Engineering, Inc., Radiflo Model Mark V as part of the licensee's maintenance program in accordance with procedures referenced in the letters dated June 28, 2016 and July 15, 2016.
15. The licensee shall not use the licensed material in or on humans except as provided otherwise by specific condition of this license.
16. This license does not authorize commercial distribution of licensed material.
17. The licensee shall maintain records of information related to decommissioning as specified in 10 CFR 30.35(g) until this license is terminated by the Commission.
18. The licensee shall not use licensed material in field applications where activity is released except as provided otherwise by specific condition of this license.
