Delivery of y-90 microspheres is nothing like y-90 Zevulin. The tumor size, blood flow dynamics, specific vascular anatomy are correlated with multiplanar imaging and dosimetry to generate a specific treatment plan for each patient. These are tasks that the Interventional radiologist is uniquely suited for. Y-90 AU status needs to remain within the capabilities of the IR. Remember, all of us have trained in diagnostic radiology including the requisite nuclear medicine training.
